## Subject: Important Notification to Pathfinder and Adventurer Clubs

Dear Family,

I trust you are well and the love of Jesus continues to shine through you. As we seek to ensure maximum involvement in our Pathfinder exams and initiatives, some adjustments have been made to the Examination schedule.

## Please take note of the rescheduled dates for Examination 2023

- 1. The Pathfinder and Adventurer Examination 2023 has been pushed back to Sunday November 12, 2023, between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.
- 2. This has been done to accommodate the delays in preparation for exam candidates for the 2023 examination.
- 3. Please note that there will be only one sitting of the examination for the 2023 examination period.
- 4. To further accommodate candidates who have not completed their club assessment activities, the Examining Committee has made the following allowances:
  - a. Candidates for whom their club has not as of October 22, 2023, submitted candidate completion scores for the club assessments will be allowed to sit the 2023 examination on November 12 under the following condition.
  - b. The scores for ALL club assessments are submitted to their area coordinator on or before midnight, January 20, 2024.
  - c. Candidates whose scores have not been submitted to their area coordinator by midnight, January 20, 2024, will have to repeat the examination in October 2024 in order to progress to the next Class.
- 5. There are therefore two categories of examination candidates sitting the November 12 examination.
  - a. Candidates in Category One
    - i. Those who have passed all club assessments, and the clubs submitted their scores to their area coordinator before October 22, 2023.



- ii. These candidates will know their exam test scores immediately after they have completed the examination on November 12.
- iii. The EJC Examination Coordinator will distribute Final Class score marks by November 22, 2023
- b. Candidates in Category Two
  - i. Those who have not yet completed their club assessments, and the clubs did not submit their scores to their area coordinator before October 22, 2023
  - ii. These candidates Will Not know their exam test scores until February 11, 2024
  - iii. This is due to the logistics of processing the final combined scores of this category of candidates.
  - iv. The EJC Examination Coordinator will distribute **Final Class score marks** by February 21, 2024.
- 6. November 5 is the new date for hosting the practical examinations (drilling and marching, and knot-tying). Area coordinators should put structures in place for this to happen by their clubs.
- 7. Candidates in both Categories (see #5 above) are eligible to participate in these practical examinations based on their class requirements.

Area coordinators, zonal examination officers and club officers should work together to ensure that candidates take advantage of the allowances offered above so that Pathfinders and Adventurers may benefit.

Please note that there will be no variation of the guidelines given in this document.
