THINGS TO TAKE/NOT TO TAKE TO CAMP

You will need: Swimming gear (bath trunk and suits no bikini), play gear, underwear, Adventurer/Pathfinder uniform, Sabbath wear, Bible, Hymnal, Quarterly, Notebook, Rubber sole shoes, Regular shoes, Socks, shoe brush and polish, needle & thread, buttons, safety pins (optional), flashlight, comb and brush, small mirror, toothbrush and paste, soap, deodorant, toilet paper, insect repellent, small basin (for girls), regular clothes (FEMALE, PANTS ONLY FOR GAMES) nightwear (pyjamas recommended for girls and boys, dusters for girls). Bed linen for a single bed, pillow (optional), eating utensils: Plates, bowls, cup/mug, fork, spoon, table knife. No sweets or foodstuff will be allowed in the camp cabins. NO RADIO, "WALKIE-TALKIE, KNIVES, DAGGERS, OR HAND GAMES.
