The Stewardship, Wills, Trust Services and Planned Giving Department of the East Jamaica Conference is pleased to invite all members to participate in our **Legal Aid Clinic**, which will be held **on this and every third Sunday of the month, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.**

This initiative has been established to provide our members with an opportunity to receive professional legal guidance and practical assistance on matters that may affect their families, finances, properties, businesses, estates, and plans.

We recognize that many of us have important legal questions but may not always know where to turn for reliable advice. Through this clinic, we want to make professional assistance more accessible to our members and help us make wise, informed, and responsible decisions.

To ensure that members receive adequate attention, four lawyers will be assigned to facilitate calls for each zone during the clinic. This arrangement will provide an opportunity for members across the Conference to access legal guidance conveniently and confidentially.

Members may seek guidance on matters such as:

- Wills and estate planning
- Property and land matters
- Probate and succession
- Family and other legal concerns
- Business and financial legal matters
- Legal documents and agreements
- Other general legal questions

As Christians, good stewardship extends beyond our finances. It also includes responsibly managing the resources, relationships, properties, and responsibilities God has entrusted to us.



Taking the time to obtain proper legal guidance can help prevent misunderstandings, reduce future complications, protect our families, and ensure that our wishes are properly communicated and documented.

Do not wait until a legal challenge arises before seeking advice. A few minutes spent receiving the right guidance today could save your family considerable difficulty tomorrow.

We therefore strongly encourage every member, every family, in each church to take advantage of this valuable opportunity. Even if you do not currently have a legal concern, consider using the clinic to review your affairs and ensure that you are adequately prepared for the future.

The Legal Aid Clinic will be held this **Sunday August 16, and every third Sunday, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon**. We encourage you to look forward to this monthly opportunity, and to share the information with family members and fellow church members.
