The Youth Ministries Department of the East Jamaica Conference of Seventh-day Adventists is thrilled to extend a heartfelt invitation to your congregation to participate in our annual Summer Camp. This highly anticipated event is dedicated to nurturing our youth for future service and leadership in society and will be held at our Phillipsfield Campsite in St. Thomas from **Tuesday, August 5th to Tuesday, August 12th, 2025.**

Our summer camp is designed for young people **aged 7 to 25, focusing** on providing a spiritually enriching and recreationally engaging environment. Our core objectives for this year's camp are:

- To provide an avenue through which youth can have positive recreational engagement.
- To help youth develop an appreciation for healthy living in nature.

This year's camp promises to be an unforgettable experience, packed with exciting and engaging activities. Some of the special features include:

- **Spiritual Emphasis:** Lights, Camera, Worship; Prayer Trail; PEEP (Pause Everything Everywhere and Pray); Bible Oscars; Faith Adventure.
- **Fun & Recreation:** FunDay Sports Day; Water Walk Challenge; Camp Got Talent.

To ensure that as many young people as possible can benefit from this transformative experience, we kindly request that each church in the East Jamaica Conference sponsor at least two **delegates** from your congregation.

**The cost for campers is as follows:**

- **Kingston and St. Andrew:** \$10,000 per camper (This includes transportation to and from the campsite and a camp t-shirt). Early bird registration for this rate expires on June 30, 2025. After this date, the cost will increase to \$11,500 per camper.
- **St. Thomas:** \$8,500 per camper (Camp t-shirt included). Early bird registration for this rate also expires on June 30, 2025. After this date, the cost will increase to \$9,500 per camper.



Registration will close on July 15, 2025.

To further share the vision and details of Summer Camp 2025, members of our dedicated camp planning team will begin church visits on **Saturday, June 7, 2025**. We respectfully request that you grant them the opportunity to make a brief presentation to your congregation, promoting the camp and addressing any questions.
