Christian greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We are pleased to announce that the **Publishing Ministries Department** and the **Community Services Department** of the East Jamaica Conference will be collaborating to host the upcoming **Week of Generosity**, with a focus on **Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder** (ADHD) awareness, scheduled for **October 12 – 18, 2025**. - 4. **Digital Literature Sharing** Members are also encouraged to use their phones and social media platforms to share e-tracks, devotionals, and other digital publications during the week.

The week will culminate on **Sabbath**, **October 18**, **2025**, which will be observed as the **Sabbath of Generosity**. We are encouraging each church to engage in the distribution of literature materials in the afternoon. This collaboration will create a powerful witness as we meet the physical needs of our communities through Community Services, while also providing spiritual hope and encouragement through the printed page.

We solicit your full support in mobilizing your members for this special week of impact. May we all experience the blessing of giving and the joy of seeing lives touched for eternity.
