HOW A WILL SHOULD BE DRAFTED.

This is the Last Will and Testament

of me, John

Milton of 173 Beeston Street in the Parish of Kingston, Clerk. I HEREBY REVOKE all Wills and testamentary dispositions heretofore made by me. I APPOINT William Shakespeare of 200 Slupe Road in the Parish of Kingston, Carpenter, and Benjamin Johnson of 4 William Street in the Parish of Kingston, Printer, to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will and Trustees hereof for all the purposes of the Settled Land and Conveyancing Laws. I DIRECT my Executors and Trustees to pay my just debts and funeral and testamentary expenses.

I GIVE AND BEQUEATH the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and the household furniture, plate, linen, china, books, pictures, glass ornaments, and other household effects being in and upon my dwelling house at 173 Beeston Street, to my wife Sarah absolutely.

I GIVE AND BEQUEATH my gold watch and cuff links to my eldest son William absolutely.

I GIVE AND BEQUEATH to my sons William, Frederick and John, and to my daughters Catherine and Mary, each the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

I GIVE AND BEQUEATH the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to the Trustees for the time being of the Jamaica Cancer Society.

I GIVE AND BEQUEATH to my Executors and Trustees the said William Shakespeare and Benjamin Johnson the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) each for their own use and benefit.

I GIVE AND DEVISE my freehold dwelling house, 173 Beeston Street, Kingston, to my said wife Sarah for her life, and after her death to my said son William in fee simple absolutely.

I GIVE AND DEVISE all my four freehold tenements situated in Beeston Street, known as Nos. 112, 114, 116 and 118 Beeston Street, Kingston, to my said son Frederick in fee simple absolutely.

I GIVE AND DEVISE my dwelling house known as No. 19 Astor Street, Kingston, to my said son John in fee simple absolutely.

AND I GIVE, DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all my real and personal property whatsoever and wheresoever situate not heretofore otherwise disposed of, to my said daughters Catherine and Mary, share and share alike, for their own separate use and benefit.
